**Go As You Please:** All horses may enter, casual dress.

**Local County Pleasure:** Horses in County show is in and all connecting counties may enter, casual dress.

**Trail Pleasure:** Horses may not show in Lite Shod or Plantation Pleasure classes.

**Country Pleasure:** Horses may not show in Trail Pleasure, Lite Shod or Plantation Pleasure classes.

**Optional Tack (OT):** Either Western tack and attire or English tack and attire. Not a combination of both.

**Youth:** Youth 11 & under must have protective headgear. Youth between 12 & 17 are encouraged to wear protective headgear.

**Coggins:** All horses must have a negative Coggins; January 1 - December 31 of current year.
